NOTICE OF FILING OF MASTER'S REPORT

This Master's Report was filed with the Montana Water Court on the above-stamped date. Please review this report carefully.

You have **13 days** from the service date of the notice of filing of this report to file a written objection or request an extension of the objection period. Rule 23, Water Right Adjudication Rules; Rule 6, Montana Rules of Civil Procedure. If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Nancy Mickelsen and Peter Mickelsen (the Mickelsens) are the record owners of irrigation claims 41S 139214-00, 41S 139220-00, and 41S 139225-00.
- 2. Claims 41S 139214-00, 41S 139220-00, and 41S 139225-00 were decreed with the following Montana Department of Natural Resources (DNRC) issue remark:

THIS CLAIM WAS INCLUDED IN A WATER COURT CASE INITIATED PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE BASIN 41S PRELIMINARY DECREE. THE CASE WAS NOT CLOSED PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE DECREE, THEREFORE THE ABSTRACT MAY NOT REFLECT THE CURRENT ELEMENTS OF THIS CLAIM AS ADJUDICATED BY THE WATER COURT.

The remark provides notice that the claims were included in Case DCERT 003-WC-2021. An Order Dismissing Case was issued on June 5, 2024, closing the Case without modifying elements of the claims. No objections were filed, and the issue remark does not raise an issue that requires further proceedings.

3. Claims 41S 139214-00, 41S 139220-00, and 41S 139225-00 were also decreed with the following source names:

41S 139225-00	Unnamed Tributary of Warm Spring Creek

A DNRC issue remark was decreed on claim 41S 139214-00 indicating the source name should be "Unnamed Tributary of Warm Spring Creek" and a remark was decreed on claims 41S 139220-00 and 41S 139225-00 indicating the source name should be "Spring, Unnamed Tributary of Warm Spring Creek."

4. An Order was issued to determine if the Mickelsens agreed with the proposed source names for claims 41S 139214-00, 41S 139220-00, and 41S 139225-00. (Doc. 11.00). The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, it would be

determined that the Mickelsens agree with the proposed source name modifications and a Master's Report would be issued.² Nothing was filed by the October 6, 2025 deadline.

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Water Court is required to resolve the issues raised by each issue remark. Mont. Code Ann. § 85-2-248 (2025).
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont. 86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.
- 3. The notice-type issue remark decreed on each of the claims in this Case has served its purpose. No objections were filed, and the remark should be removed from the claims.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The source name for claim 41S 139214-00 should be modified to
 "Unnamed Tributary of Warm Spring Creek." The source name for claims 41S 139220-00 and 41S 139225-00 should be modified to "Spring, Unnamed Tributary of Warm Spring Creek."
 - 2. The issue remarks should be removed from the claims in this Case. Abstracts are attached for review.
