CORRECTION ORDER

On September 3, 2025, the Court issued an Order Approving Stipulation and Closing Case. (Doc. 14.00). On September 12, 2025, objectors Greg H. Langford, and Vickie L. Langford ("Langford") filed an objection to the Order. (Doc. 15.00). The objection contends the Order failed to properly modify the period of diversion for stock water right claim 43BV 150303-00. Cremer Rodeo Land & Livestock Co. ("Cremer") owns the claim.

To recap, claim 43BV 150303-00 is a claim for stock water with a June 1, 1880 priority date. The claim previously was consolidated in case 43BV-0230-R-2024 along with several other claims owned by Cremer, including irrigation claim 43BV 150321-00. Claims 43BV 150321-00 and 43BV 150303-00 are multiple uses of the same decreed right. As part of a larger stipulation in case 43BV-0230-R-2024, Cremer agreed to limit the period of diversion for claim 43BV 150321-00 to April 15 to October 15. The

stipulation in that case did not address claim 43BV 150303-00 or any other Cremer stock water claim.

As part of the closing of case 43BV-0230-R-2024, the Court reconsolidated claims 43BV 150321-00 and 43BV 150303-00 into this case. When the Court approved the stipulation between the parties, it assumed the period of diversion and period of use for stock water claim 43BV 150303-00 would not be modified. Langford's objection to the order argues this assumption was incorrect, and the periods of diversion and use should be April 15 to October 15, to mirror the periods for irrigation claim 43BV 150321-00.

More than 14 days have passed and Cremer has not responded to Langford's motion. Pursuant to Uniform District Court Rule 2(c), the Court may treat the failure to respond as an admission that the motion is well taken.

Langford's motion does not specify a legal basis for relief, other than identifying the Court's incorrect reading of the stipulation (which Langford concedes contains a typographical error). The Court regards the request as clerical in nature as it corrects what the parties intended in the stipulation. Clerical corrections are within the Court's authority under Rule 60(a) of the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED, that Langford's objection is treated as a motion to correct and is GRANTED. The periods of diversion and use for claim 43BV 150303-00 are modified to April 15 to October 15.

A revised post-decree abstract of claim 43BV 150303-00 is included with this Order to confirm the modifications have been made in the State's centralized water rights record system.
