

Registration, of Municipal Tax Payers. Tax Payers, Registration Of.

There is no duty devolving upon the county clerk to list as such the tax payers of a municipality upon his registration book.

Dear Sir:

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 8th inst., in which you request my official opinion as to whether or not under the provisions of Chapter 113, Laws of 1911, it is the duty of the county clerk to register municipal tax payers as such.

It is my opinion that Chap. 113, Laws of 1911, does not apply to municipal elections other than general and that no duty devolves upon

the county clerk by virtue of that law to register the tax payers of a municipality, nor to furnish a list of such tax payers at any election at which the tax payers as such are called upon to vote.
