Under the provisions of Section 2921, Revised Codes, the county board may transfer surplus moneys from one fund to another fund when the interest of the county demand such transfer.

Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 19th instant, submitting the question:

“Has the board of county commissioners the authority to transfer surplus moneys from the general fund to the bridge fund, for the purpose of redeeming registered outstanding warrants drawn against the bridge fund?”

The provisions of Sec. 2921, Revised Codes, clearly confers this authority upon the county board whenever the interests of the county demand that it be done, and there is surplus money to be transferred.
