I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, submitting the question:

“As to whether it is the duty of the state examiner to examine the books and records of the county free high schools of the various counties of this state?”

A county free high school is in effect a county charge, and the provisions of Sec. 209, and the provisions of the various subdivisions thereof, in my opinion, do apply to county free high schools.
