You ask for an opinion as to whether or not a fee shall be charged by a clerk of court, and if so what fee, on the transfer of guardianship proceedings. (Chapter 21 of the 1933 Session Laws.)

In such a case, petitioners have already paid a fee in the county where the papers were originally filed. The law does not require specifically the payment of any other fee on the transfer of papers to a second county.

I therefore conclude that no fee need be paid to the clerk of court of the county to which such papers are transferred.

**Opinion No. 224**

**Clerk of Court—Guardianship Proceedings—Fee on Transfer of Proceedings.**

HELD: No fee need be paid to the
