

Opinion No. 230**High Schools—Warrants—Funding
Bonds.**

HELD: Chapter 160, Laws of 1933, does not authorize the issuance of funding bonds to take up high school warrants.

You ask whether or not Chapter 160, Laws of 1933, will authorize the issuance of funding bonds to take up high school warrants.

I would advise you that from an examination of said Chapter 160, it appears that the same is limited to warrants of school districts. The issuance of bonds for county high schools is covered by entirely different provisions of our statutes, and it is my opinion that this law was intended to cover and apply solely to school districts in the ordinary sense. It is not intended nor construed so as to permit the issuing of funding bonds to take up warrants of district high schools.
