## Aliens-Employment-State Institutions.

HELD: There is no statute forbidding the employment of aliens in state institutions.

You have submitted the following:

"Is there a law on the statute books prohibiting the employment of an alien in any state institution?

"Should the answer to this question be in the affirmative: Then: If an alien has properly made a decla-ration of intention to become a citizen of the United States does the fact alter his or her status under the law with reference to his or her employment in a state institution?"

In answer to your first question, I wish to advise that I find no statute prohibiting the employment of an alien in any state institution. This being the case, an answer to

your second question is unnecessary.
