



Software Version Updates

E-File Version Updates: Installed May 10th, 2024

- **V7.6.3** attempted to improve E-Filing performance, created a problem entering case number and with the Judge Review Queue
- **V7.6.4** Fixed a problem with the Justice Review Queue, fixed a problem entering the case number, attempted to fix the problem with the Judge Review Queue
- V7.6.5 Attempted to fix a problem with the Judge Review Queue
- V7.6.6 Fixed the problem with the Judge Review Queue

FCE Version Updates: Installed December 11th, 2023

- **V8.3** No longer sends dismissed litigants to E-File, updated the Pending Electronic Filings queue filter to include "all" case type options, fixed a problem with unsealing documents while processing e-filings
- V8.3 Patch 1 Fixed a problem with the Address Line 2 field not importing
- V8.3 Maintenance 1 Fixed a problem with document sequence numbers trying to duplicate

Other Updates

- Enabled Adoption, Guardianship, Paternity, and Probate case types at the District Courts
- Enabled Small Claims at the Limited Jurisdiction Courts
- Updated the statute table
- Removed the "Filed on Behalf of" field for certain subtypes
- Fixed a problem with the ESB that was caused by submitting a filing over 80
 MB crashing the system
- Potentially fixed a problem with the clerks being unable to process certain E-Filings
- Removed the extra ROA on new criminal cases at the District Courts

Outstanding Problems

- State abbreviation is missing in address on COS
- ROA does not always accurately describe who the filer is when payment is present
- Unable to assign multiple prosecutors to DJ cases
- Judge review queue sometimes displays the wrong motion
- Occasional problem auto assigning a judge
- Occasional "User Not Authorized" error
- Received of field does not auto populate

- Adlib failures after maintenance weekends
- Processing an E-Filing on a case removes the "Date of Death" from a deceased person
- Unable to switch E-File users' roles some users unable to register as a result
- E-Filing eServed the wrong documents

Software Vendors

E-Filing – Thomson Reuters

- TR desires to retire Montana e-Filing
- Believed could make more money on additional filing fees passed to filers
- They cannot sustain maintenance relationship
- Maintenance commitment through 6/30/2027

JSI/FSX E-Filing Partnership

- Currently working with TR customers
- Awaiting an FSX FCE Integration Proposal
- Proposal to Governor's Office, then to 2025 Legislature
- Hoping for Sole Source Approval (no RFP)

Trial Court CMS – Justice Systems Inc.

- JSI bought by Avenu Insights & Analytics (January 2024)
- Looking for robust CMS (FullCourt Enterprise)
- Interested in quick and substantial investment in JSI products and team
- 500 JSI customer contracts to transition

- Search by 'other party' name Waiting for SOW





