

- Pending Electronic Filing Case Type (subtypes) filter is unusable – **Pending install**
- State abbreviation is missing in address on COS
- ROA does not always accurately describe who the filer is when payment is present

- Judge review queue sometimes displays the wrong motion
- Occasional problem auto assigning a judge
- Occasional "User Not Authorized" error
- 3 AM filing errors (maybe fixed with v7.6.1)
- E-Filing Performance
- Adlib failures after maintenance weekends

ENHANCEMENT REQUESTS FOR THE VENDORS

Enhancement Requests

Thomson Reuters

- Auto Plaintiff for SL and SW case types In development
- Automatically fill in the first document filing type and subtype on the upload document page - Unapproved
- Make the filing type and subtype fields searchable - Unapproved
- Add a comment box on the attorney's filing summary page – Unapproved
- Save 'Other Service Recipients' Not yet requested
- Search by 'other party' name Not yet requested
- Judges to change queue sort order Up for discussion

FinVi/JSI

- Mapping filing types to ROA codes (e.g., Motion – Unopposed) – In development
- Make the 'Route to Judge' field a required field – Pending approval
- ROA shows if filing was routed to the judge waiting for SOW

New Vendor Enhancement Request

Automatically send out orders submitted by the judge
