
Executive Order Closing Areas of Extreme Fire Danger to Hunting
and Fishing

Because of extreme fire danger, the State Forester has recommended closing certain areas to hunting and fishing until further notice.

THEREFORE, I, FORREST H. ANDERSON, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me under Section 26-345, Revised Codes of Montana, 1947, order that the following areas be closed to hunting and fishing immediately and until opened by further order:

Blaine, Carter, that portion of Chouteau County north and east of the Marias and Missouri Rivers, Custer, Dawson, Fallon, Fergus, Garfield, Hill, Liberty, McCone, Petroleum, Phillips, Powder River, Prairie, Richland, Rosebud, Treasure, Valley and Wibaux Counties.
