Executive Order Declaring an Emergency in Glacier County.

Chapter 409, Laws of Montana, 1971, authorizes the Governor to declare emergencies when certain conditions result in damage to the property of the state or menace the health, welfare, safety, lives or property of any considerable number of persons in any county.

The County Commissioners of Glacier County have demonstrated that their county has exhausted all available emergency levies in attempting to alleviate extreme snow conditions which have blocked roads for an extended period of time, creating a menace to the people of Glacier County.


The members of the Governor's Disaster Advisory Council have recommended expending emergency funds authorized by Chapter 409, Laws of Montana, 1971, to assist Glacier County.

THEREFORE, I, FORREST H. ANDERSON, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to Chapter 409, Laws of Montana, 1971, declare an emergency in Glacier County caused by severe snow and drifting conditions and authorize the expenditure of \$43,740 in emergency funds under the provisions of Chapter 409, Laws of Montana, 1971.
