EXECUTIVE ORDER 1-75

RESCINDED
2-1-82

Executive Order designating Ronald P. Richards, William A. Groff,
and Michael G. Billings as a task force to represent the State of Montana
in collective bargaining with duly certified exclusive representatives
for the purpose of resolving differences over the classification and
grading of employees of the executive branch under the provisions of
Title 59, Chapter 9, R.C.M. 1947.

Section 59-1609, R.C.M. 1947 provides that the Governor or his
designee shall represent the State in collective bargaining with exclusive
representatives.


Section 59-906, R.C.M. 1947 provides that the classification plan
shall group all positions in the state service into defined classes
based on the similarity of duties performed, responsibilities assumed,
and complexity of work.

In order to assure that the requirements of Section 59-906, R.C.M.
1947 are adequately met, a review of the classification plan by duly
certified exclusive representatives is necessary.


THEREFORE, I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, Governor of the State of Montana,
hereby designate Ronald P. Richards, William A. Groff, and Michael G.
Billings as a task force to represent the State of Montana in collective
bargaining with duly certified exclusive representatives for the purpose
of resolving differences over the classification and grading of employees
of the executive branch under the provisions of Title 59, Chapter 9,
R.C.M. 1947.
