Executive Order continuing and expanding the membership of the Governmental Accounting Policy Council for the Executive Branch, and rescinding Executive Order No. 6-77.

I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, in accordance with the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, do hereby continue the Governmental Accounting Policy Council established in Executive Order No. 6-77 for the Executive Branch of state government.

The Governmental Accounting Policy Council shall establish all policy governing accounting principles and procedures which apply to operations of state government. The Council is responsible for resolving all agency and interagency accounting problems arising from these principles and its procedures.

The members of the Governmental Accounting Policy Council consist of:
