EXECUTIVE ORDER NO 1-88


EXECUTIVE ORDER DESIGNATING NOVEMBER 25, 1988 AS
HERITAGE DAY

WHEREAS, 1-1-216(1)(I), MCA, creates a legal holiday
denominated "Heritage Day."


WHEREAS, that statute provides that Heritage Day is to be
observed by the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of state
government, including the university system, on the day designated
by the Governor.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, by virtue of the
authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution of Montana and
1-1-216(1)(I), do hereby order and declare that November 25, 1988, is
designated Heritage Day for calendar year 1988 for all executive,
legislative, and judicial employees of the State of Montana.
