EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING EMERGENCY
CLOSURE OF PLENTYWOOD SCHOOL

WHEREAS, on December 19, 1990 a fire destroyed and/or severely damaged buildings of Plentywood School District; and


WHEREAS, as a result of this fire, Plentywood School was not convened and pupil instruction days previously scheduled were not provided; and

WHEREAS, the boards of trustees of Elementary School District No. 20 and High School District No. 20 have determined that it is in the best interest of the school district that the Governor of Montana be requested to declare a school emergency closure for both elementary and high school districts Number 20 for the period of time commencing December 19, 1990 through January 6, 1991; and

WHEREAS, such school emergency closure will permit Plentywood school districts to receive school equalization payments without the need to make up five days of pupil instruction.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, by the power vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana declare, pursuant to Section 20-9-806, MCA, that a school emergency existed for Elementary School District No. 20 and High School District No. 20, Plentywood, Montana for the period of time commencing December 19, 1990 through January 6, 1991 and that such school districts shall be entitled to receive full equalization appropriation for the five pupil instruction days lost as a result of the emergency.
