EXECUTIVE ORDER 2-72

STATE OF MONTANA

Office of the Governor

PROVIDING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND REHABILITATION SERVICES SHALL UNDERTAKE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A STATEWIDE YOUTH SERVICE SYSTEM TO SUPPLEMENT OTHER STATE AND LOCAL EFFORTS THROUGH PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT, COORDINATION AND COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION.

WHEREAS, prevention of juvenile delinquency constitutes a national and state problem which must be met by coordinated state, local government and private agency planning and action; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services is engaged in program development and comprehensive planning for preventing youth from entering the Juvenile Justice System and criminal careers, requiring close coordination and interrelationship with other state and local youth service agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Governor of the State of Montana, I, FORREST H. ANDERSON, designate the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services as the responsible state agency to seek and receive federal support necessary to implement a state-wide Youth Service System for youth development and delinquency prevention, coordination and comprehensive planning.
