Executive Order No. 2-81

Executive Order transferring the Office of Commerce and Small Business Development to the Department of Business Regulation.

I, TED SCHWINDEN, in accordance with the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, and in recognition of the need to provide an atmosphere conducive to economic development in the State of Montana, I hereby order as follows:

(1) That the Office of Commerce and Small Business Development presently situated in the Office of the Governor be transferred to the Department of Business Regulation effective as of February 3, 1981.

(2) That the Office of Commerce and Small Business Development which was originally formed in October 1974, and subsequently and continually authorized by the Montana legislature, shall continue to:


(a) Assist the Governor through the Department of Business Regulation to develop and implement economic policy, planning, and strategies for the State of Montana, and to

(b) Assist the Governor through the Department of Business Regulation to develop programs capable of assisting state businesses with funding and technical assistance to maintain and create jobs.
