EXECUTIVE ORDER 3-75

Executive Order rescinding Executive Order 1-75 and abolishing the task force created therein.

Executive Order 1-75 created a task force to represent the State of Montana in collective bargaining with duly certified exclusive representatives for the purpose of resolving differences over the classification and grading of employees of the executive branch under the provisions of Title 59, Chapter 9, R.C.M. 1947.


The task force was necessary because Section 59-1609, R.C.M. 1947 provides that the Governor, or his designee, shall represent the State in collective bargaining with exclusive representatives; Section 59-906, R.C.M. 1947 provides that the classification plan shall group all positions in the state service into defined classes based on the similarity of duties performed, responsibilities assumed and complexity of work; and because insuring that the requirements of 59-906 R.C.M. 1947 were met necessitated a review of the classification plan by duly certified exclusive representatives.

The task force requested that all exclusive representatives review the classification plan and upon the request of the exclusive representatives negotiated with them to mutually achieve the appropriate grade and step for all represented employees before February 20, 1975. All such requests were honored and proper classifications were achieved through the negotiations process, thereby eliminating any need for the continuation of the task force.
