EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE  
MONTANA MEDAL OF VALOR ADVISORY COUNCIL

---

WHEREAS, the 49th Legislature passed House Bill 871 (Chapter 537) which was signed into law on April 18, 1985; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 871 establishes a Montana Medal of Valor and authorizes the Governor to present a medal to any citizens who display extraordinary courage in a situation threatening the lives of one or more people.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me in accordance with Section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby create the "Montana Medal of Valor Advisory Council."

I. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

The composition of the council shall not exceed five members. The names and addresses of the members who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor are:

Representative Jan Brown shall serve as chairperson of the Advisory Council.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the council shall be to gather information, furnish advice, and make recommendations to the Governor and perform such other activities as may be necessary regarding the Montana Medal of Valor. Specifically, the council shall recommend to the Governor:


- the design and production of a medal to be known as the "Montana Medal of Valor," bearing a suitable inscription and ribbon.
- names of individuals to be considered as recipients of the Montana Medal of Valor.

III. EXISTENCE.


The council shall exist until January 6, 1988.
