EXECUTIVE ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1-86

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 1-86 continues the Capital Finance Advisory Council and includes in the membership of the Council directors of departments and chairpersons of boards authorized to issue obligations,

WHEREAS, the 50th Legislature has passed legislation authorizing the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to issue obligations and merging the Board of Investments and the Economic Development Board,

WHEREAS, the composition of the Capital Finance Advisory Council should be changed accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby amend Executive Order No. 1-86 by deleting therefrom existing Section II and substituting therefor:

"II. Composition.

This Council shall have 15 members consisting of the following persons or their designees:

Director Office of Budget and Program Planning

Department Directors:

Administration Agriculture Commerce Highways
Natural Resources and Conservation Health and Environmental Sciences

Board/Authority/Corporation Chairpersons:

Board of Regents of Higher Education
Board of Housing
Board of Investments
Health Facilities Authority
Agricultural Loan Authority
Higher Education Student Assistance Corporation


Legislators:

The Council shall be chaired by the Director of the Department of Administration and shall be attached to the department for administrative purposes. Employees of the Department of Administration shall serve as staff to the Council as directed by the chairperson."

This Order is effective July 1, 1987.
