Executive Order No. 3-93

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CONTINUING THE YOUTH JUSTICE ADVISORY COUNCIL WITHIN THE
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BOARD OF CRIME CONTROL, TO IMPLEMENT
THE JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION ACT

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I, MARC RACICOT, Governor of the State of Montana, do
hereby order the continuation of the Youth Justice Advisory
Council within the Department of Justice, Board of Crime
Control pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA, and as required by
Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention
Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-415), as amended.

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I. PURPOSE

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The purpose of the Council is to:

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- a. advise the Governor and the Board of Crime Control
on policy matters related to juvenile justice;
 - b. supervise the preparation, complete administration
and implementation of the Juvenile Justice and
Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as required by
Section 223 of the Act;
 - c. approve the annual plan as required by the Juvenile

1 Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as
2 amended, and award grants to implement that plan;

3 d. advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control and
4 the Legislature on legislation relating to juvenile
5 delinquency and compliance with the Juvenile
6 Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act; and

7 e. advise state, local and private agencies on
8 juvenile justice in order to better coordinate
9 services and to most efficiently utilize available
10 resources.

11 II. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

12 The composition of the Council shall not exceed 18
13 members. The names and addresses of members who shall serve
14 at the pleasure of the Governor are submitted by separate
15 letter to the Secretary of State and to the Board of Crime
16 Control.

17 III. COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL

18 Council members eligible for compensation under 2-15-
19 122(5) MCA shall be compensated \$25 for each day actually and
20 necessarily engaged in performance of Council duties. All
21 Council members who are not full-time state employees shall be
22 reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to 2-15-122(5) MCA.

23 IV. TERMINATION OF PRIOR EXECUTIVE ORDER

24 Any provisions of prior Executive Orders relating to the
25 Youth Service Advisory Council are hereby superseded by the
26 provision of this Order.

V. DURATION

2 The Council shall exist until two years from the
3 effective date of this order. This Order shall be effective
4 immediately.
