EXECUTIVE ORDER RE-ESTABLISHING
THE MONTANA MEDAL OF VALOR ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Section 1-1-515, MCA, authorizes the Governor of the State of Montana to present, in the name of the people of Montana, a medal to be known as the "Montana Medal of Valor" to any citizen of the state who displays extraordinary courage in a situation threatening the lives of one or more persons.

NOW THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 1-1-515, MCA, and 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby re-establish the Governor's Montana Medal of Valor Advisory Council.

I. PURPOSE.

The purpose of the Council shall be 1) to gather information, 2) furnish advice, 3) make recommendations to the Governor and perform such other activities as may be necessary regarding the Montana Medal of Valor, and 4) from time to time submit names of individuals as well as a summary of necessary information for the Governor to consider as worthy recipients of the Montana Medal of Valor.

II. COMPOSITION


Jan Brown shall be chair of this advisory council.

This Council shall remain in effect for a period of two years from the date of this Order.


This Order is effective immediately.
