EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE PEACE OFFICERS  
STANDARDS AND TRAINING ADVISORY COUNCIL

11 I, MARC RACICOT, by virtue of the authority vested in me as  
12 Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana,  
13 and specifically pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby  
14 continue the existing Peace Officers Standards and Training  
15 Advisory Council within the Board of Crime Control.

16 I. PURPOSE

17 The Council shall establish priorities, aid in planning  
18 programs, and make recommendations regarding the improvement of  
19 law enforcement in the State of Montana.

20 II. COMPOSITION

21 A. The Peace Officers Standards and Training Advisory  
22 Council shall be composed of 15 members. The names and  
23 addresses of members who shall serve at the pleasure of the  
24 Governor are submitted by separate letter to the Attorney  
25 General and the Secretary of State.

26 III. DURATION


27 The Council shall exist for a period of two years from the  
28 effective date of this Order unless otherwise ordered by
