
Executive Order For Opening Hunting and Fishing In Areas  
Previously Closed by Executive Orders Nos. 1-71, 3-71, and  
4-71.

Because the State Forester has reported that the extreme fire danger has now passed and has recommended that those areas previously closed to hunting and fishing now be opened, and pursuant to the authority vested in me under Section 26-345, Revised Codes of Montana, 1947, I, Thomas L. Judge, Acting Governor of the State of Montana, order the following counties now open to hunting and fishing:

Blaine, Carter, that portion of Chouteau County north and east of the Marias and Missouri Rivers, Custer, Dawson, Fallon, Fergus, Garfield, Hill, Liberty, McCone, Petroleum, Phillips, Powder River, Prairie, Richland, Rosebud, Treasure, Valley, Wibaux, Meagher, Musselshell, Judith Basin, and Golden Valley.
