Executive Order No. 5-81

Executive Order creating a new Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice to implement the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act as amended.

---

I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana hereby abolish the Youth Justice Advisory Council created on December 18, 1975 and re-establish a new Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1981, pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA and required by Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-415) as amended by Public Laws 94-503, 95-115, and 96-509.

The composition of the Council shall not exceed 18 members. The qualifications of each member must be consistent with the requirements of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act. The names and addresses of members who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor are:

The purpose of the Council shall be to:

Implement the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act as amended.

Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control, and the Legislature regarding Montana's compliance with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Act as well as other matters relating to juvenile delinquency in Montana.

Ensure that juvenile justice planning and research efforts be maintained as an integral part of state government.

Work with related government and private agencies to assure the coordination of activities and resources designed to improve juvenile justice in Montana.


The Council shall exist until it is no longer required for receipt of federal funds.

I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 2-15-122, MCA do hereby approve the creation of the new Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice, on this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1980.
