EXECUTIVE ORDER 6-76


Executive Order rescinding Executive Order 3-74 and in lieu thereof, designating the previously created Montana Energy Advisory Council as the State Office of Petroleum Allocation, to administer the State set-aside provisions to meet hardship and emergency requirements of all wholesale purchasers and end-users within the State from the volumes of products specified in Part 211 of Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, as State set-aside volumes for: middle distillate fuels, motor gasoline, residual fuel oil (except for utility use) and propane, in the State of Montana.

I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Montana, and the Economic Stabilization Act of 1970 (Public Law 92-210) as amended by the Economic Stabilization Act Amendments of 1973 (Public Law 93-28), and the rules adopted pursuant thereto, do hereby rescind Executive Order 3-74, and in lieu thereof, designate the Montana Energy Advisory Council as the State Office of Petroleum Allocation and hereby order that Council to administer the State set-aside provisions and end-user allocation programs for middle distillates, motor gasoline, residual fuel oil (except for utility use), and propane in the State of Montana. I further order that the fuel allocation program now assigned to and conducted by the Civil Defense Agency of the Department of Military Affairs shall henceforth be assigned to and conducted by the Montana Energy Advisory Council. I further declare that this order is necessary to effectively and efficiently administer the state fuel allocation program within the executive branch.


This Executive Order shall be effective as of July 1, 1976.


