Executive Order establishing a Governmental Accounting Policy Council for the Executive Branch, and establishing the composition and responsibilities of the Council.


I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me by article VI, sections 4(1) and 8(1), of the 1972 Montana Constitution, hereby establish, for the executive branch of state government, the Governmental Accounting Policy Council and the Council's composition and responsibilities:

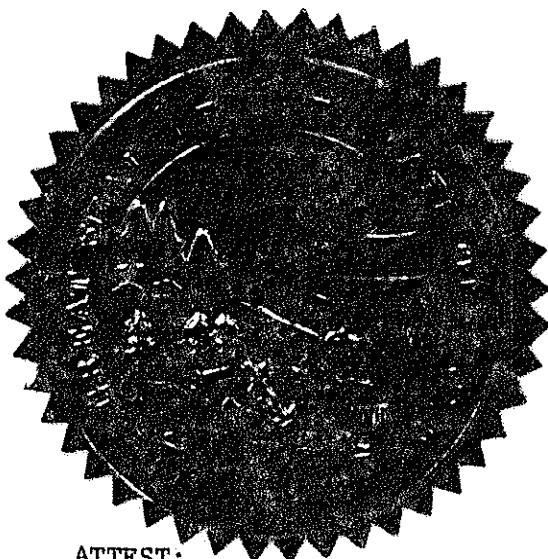
1. I hereby create the Governmental Accounting Policy Council, to establish all policy governing accounting principles and procedures which apply to operations of state government.

2. The Governmental Accounting Policy Council consists of: Michael G. Billings, Chairman; Ray Dore; Jack C. Crosser; and Lawrence K. Pettit.


3. The Governmental Accounting Policy Council has sole responsibility for all policy decisions relating to state government accounting principles and procedures, and is responsible for resolving all agency and inter-agency accounting problems.
