

ENFORCEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE  
AS A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY PURSUANT TO THE  
MONTANA CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION ACT OF 1979

I, Ted Schwinden, in accordance with the authority vested in me as Governor by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, do hereby repeal Executive Order 1-82 and pursuant to the Montana Criminal Justice Information Act of 1979 (Title 44, Chapter 5, MCA), do hereby designate the Investigations and Enforcement Division of the Department of Revenue, as a "criminal justice agency."
