Executive Order No. 8-94

EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE GOVERNOR'S ADVISORY COUNCIL
ON CORRECTIONS AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE POLICY

I, MARC RACICOT, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, and specifically pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby establish a Governor's Advisory Council on Corrections and Criminal Justice Policy.

I. PURPOSE

The Council shall aid in planning programs, and make recommendations regarding the improvement of corrections and criminal justice policy in the State of Montana.

II. COMPOSITION

A. The Corrections and Criminal Justice Policy Advisory Council shall be composed of seventeen members. The names and addresses of members who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor are submitted by separate letter to the Attorney General and the Secretary of State.
