Executive Order Allocating the Administration of the Developmental Disabilities Services and Facilities Act of 1974" to the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services, and providing for an effective date.

The Second Session of the Forty-third Legislature enacted the "Montana Developmental Disabilities Services and Facilities Act of 1974", Chapter 325, Laws of Montana 1974, effective January 1, 1975.


The Legislature did not allocate the administration of that Act to a department of the Executive Branch, but merely provided that the State of Montana should administer it.

Section 82A-115, R.C.M. 1947, requires that the Governor shall, by executive order, allocate a function to the appropriate principal department if it is not so allocated by any act of the Legislature.

THEREFORE, I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, Governor of the State of Montana, by the authority vested in me under Sections 82A-115 and 82-1315, R.C.M. 1947, allocate the administration of the "Montana Developmental Disabilities Services and Facilities Act of 1974" to the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services.

This Executive Order shall be effective September 1, 1974.
