
Executive Order setting forth procedure wherein state employees will be dismissed from state employment upon third offense speeding violations.


I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, in accordance with the authority vested in me as Governor by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, hereby direct that:

1. The following procedure will apply to any state employee upon conviction for exceeding the speed limit while on state business: first offense, notification to agency; second offense, official reprimand with copy to permanent personnel file; third offense, dismissal from state employment.
2. "Conviction" is used as that term is defined in 61-11-203, MCA, and includes forfeiture of bail. "Speeding" and "exceeding the speed limit" includes violations based upon 61-8-303 and 61-8-304, MCA.
3. The provisions of this Order shall be made available to all state employees using vehicles through the state motor pool.
