EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING AN EMERGENCY IN DEER LODGE COUNTY

WHEREAS, an escape has occurred from the State Hospital, Warm Springs, Montana, Deer Lodge County; and

WHEREAS, the escaped individuals are considered dangerous and pose a threat to the safety of the citizens of Montana; and

WHEREAS, city and county resources are inadequate to locate the individuals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Anaconda has requested assistance from the State to include equipment and personnel from the Montana National Guard; and

WHEREAS, the threat to Montana Citizens safety constitutes an emergency; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation of emergency authorizes the Governor to activate the National Guard to protect life, health and property and authorizes the Governor under Section 10-3-311, MCA, to expend funds from the general fund to meet contingencies and needs arising from an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor under the Constitution of the State of Montana and Title 10, Chapter 3, MCA do hereby declare that a emergency exists in the County of Deer Lodge.
