
Executive Order rescinding Executive Order No. 7-74 and designating the Office of Budget and Program Planning as the official state agency to receive and disburse funds pertaining to Montana's participation in the United States Bicentennial Anniversary, and to conduct all final business pertaining to Montana's Bicentennial program.

Montana's participation in the United States Bicentennial Anniversary is nearly complete, and the Montana Bicentennial Administration ceased official operations on January 14, 1977. However, certain final Bicentennial business remains unfinished and must be completed as soon as possible.

THEREFORE, I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me, rescind Executive Order 7-74, and designate the Office of Budget and Program Planning of the Governor's Office as the official state agency to receive and disburse all funds pertaining to Montana's participation in the United States Bicentennial Anniversary, including all funds received or disbursed after January 14, 1977. The Office of Budget and Program Planning has full authority and responsibility, under this order, to do all things necessary to complete and terminate all remaining business of Montana's Bicentennial program, and this order shall remain in effect until I am notified in writing by the Director of the Office of Budget and Program Planning that all such business has been completed and terminated to his satisfaction.
