



Executive Order declaring state of emergency in West Fork of Barker Creek near Anaconda, Montana.

I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, in accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, do hereby declare, effective August 5, 1979, that a state of emergency exists within the State of Montana due to an uncontrolled fire in the West Fork of Barker Creek near Anaconda, Montana and direct the Adjutant General, Department of Military Affairs, to order to state active duty such units and personnel of the Montana National Guard as may be required to render aid and assistance in the evacuation of people in the vicinity of Anaconda, Montana, and to help in the suppression of fire threatened homes. Pay and expenses as a result of this duty will be processed in accordance with Sections 10-1-501 and 10-1-1502, MCA.

Given under my hand and the GREAT SEAL of the State of Montana this 5th day of August, in the year of our LORD, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.
