WHEREAS, the Mayor and all members of the White Sulphur Springs City Council resigned their elected positions on July 10, 1985; and

WHEREAS, an office becomes vacant when an incumbent resigns; and

WHEREAS, section 7-4-4112, M.C.A., provides that a vacant municipal office is normally filled by a majority vote of the remaining members which seat is then subject to nomination and election at the next general election; and

WHEREAS, there are no remaining council members to carry out the procedures contemplated in section 7-4-4112, MCA; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has issued an opinion that when the method for filling vacancies can not be utilized, the Governor is authorized, under section 2-15-506(1), MCA, to appoint persons to fill the unexpired terms of the vacancies created.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, and specifically section 2-16-506(1), MCA, do hereby appoint the following persons to serve the designated terms in the listed wards.


