EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE HEALTH COORDINATING  
ADVISORY COUNCIL

---

I, TED SCHWINDEN, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor, under the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, and specifically pursuant to section 2-15-122, MCA, hereby continue the Health Coordinating Advisory Council established in Executive Order No. 22-81.

I. Composition

II. Purpose

The Montana Health Coordinating Advisory Council shall serve as the state health coordinating council as provided in 42 U.S.C., 300 m.3 as amended.
