EXECUTIVE ORDER RECREATING THE
MONTANA HISTORICAL RECORDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Public Law 93-536, requires the Governor of each state desiring to participate in the National Historical Publications Program to establish a Historical Records Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, the State of Montana has demonstrated an interest in the care of historical records.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, specifically 2-15-122, MCA, and Public Law 93-536, do hereby recreate the Montana Historical Records Advisory Council.

I. PURPOSE

Pursuant to Public Law 93-536 and the implementing regulations, the Council shall serve as the central advisory body in the State of Montana for the care, storage, and disposition of historical records, and shall review and evaluate grant proposals made to the National Historical Publications and Records Commission (National Archives and Records Administration). The Council is authorized to receive funds pursuant to Pub. Law 93-536.

II. COMPOSITION

The Council shall consist of eight members who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The names and addresses of the appointees are:

III. DURATION


The Council shall exist for a period of two years from the effective date of this Order unless extended by Executive Order.
