Executive Order No. 11-93

**EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING A DISASTER
TO EXIST IN CUSTER COUNTY**

12 WHEREAS, heavy rains produced flash flooding in early
13 July which caused severe widespread damage to county roads and
14 culverts in Custer County; and

15 WHEREAS, Custer County has committed all available
16 resources, taken all possible actions to respond, mitigate and
17 alleviate the situation, and the local resources are not
18 sufficient to meet the conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of Commissioners has
20 exhausted all available emergency levies by appropriating
21 emergency funding in an amount equivalent to a two (2) mill
22 levy on the taxable valuation of the county outside the
23 incorporated municipalities pursuant to Section 10-3-405, MCA,
24 and has requested that an Executive Order be issued declaring
25 a disaster to exist in Custer County as a result of the
26 flooding; and

27 WHEREAS, Custer County is an active participant in the

National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation of an emergency or disaster authorizes the Governor under Section 10-3-311, MCA, to expend funds from the general fund to meet contingencies and needs arising from these conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARC RACICOT, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor under the Constitution of the State of Montana and Title 10, Chapter 3, MCA, and under other applicable statutes, do hereby declare a disaster to exist in Custer County.

This Order is effective immediately.
