EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE YOUTH SERVICE ADVISORY COUNCIL
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO IMPLEMENT THE JUVENILE JUSTICE
AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION ACT
AND TO ADVISE THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES

I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, hereby repeal Executive Order No. 20-87, and continue the Youth Service Advisory Council within the Department of Justice pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA, and as required by Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-415), as amended and to advise the Director of the Department of Family Services on policies relating to children and youth pursuant to Section 52-1-202, MCA.

I. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Council is to:

- a. Advise the Governor, the Director of the Department of Family Services and the Board of Crime Control on policy matters related to juvenile justice, child welfare and youth services.
- b. Supervise the preparation, complete administration and implementation of the Juvenile Justice and Prevention Act of 1974, as amended, as required by S. 223 of the Act.
- c. Approve the annual plan as required by the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended and award grants to implement that plan.
- d. Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control and the legislature on legislation relating to juvenile delinquency, child welfare, youth services and compliance with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.

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- e. Advise state, local and private agencies on juvenile justice, youth services and child welfare policies in order to better coordinate services and to most efficiently utilize available resources.
- f. Review and make recommendations to the Department of Family Services on a state plan for community based services for children and youth.
- g. Advise the Department of Family Services on policies and procedures for local youth services plans, as provided in 52-1-202, MCA.


III. COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL

Council members eligible for compensation under 2-15-122(5) shall be compensated \$25 for each day actually and necessarily engaged in performance of Council duties. All council members who are not full-time state employees shall be reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to 2-15-122(5).

IV. DURATION

The Council shall exist until June 22, 1991. This Order is effective June 22, 1989.
