EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING THE CLOSURE OF
THE YELLOWSTONE RIVER IN PARK COUNTY

WHEREAS, the flooding in Park County is requiring use of
emergency personnel for the flood fight; and

WHEREAS, citizen use of the Yellowstone River is more
hazardous than normal; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation of an emergency or disaster under
Section 10-3-104 and 10-3-311, MCA, authorizes the Governor to
control ingress and egress or suspend provisions of any
regulatory statute or rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARC RACICOT, Governor of the State of
Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor
under the Constitution of the State of Montana, Title 10,
Chapter 3, MCA, and under other applicable statutes, do hereby
close the Yellowstone River within the boundaries of Park
County to floating, boating, swimming, wading, or other
recreational activities until such time that conditions
warrant rescinding this order or the Emergency Declaration
