EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14-83

Executive Order creating the Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice to implement the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act as amended.

I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, hereby repeal Executive Order No. 5-81 and create the Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA and as required by Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-415) as amended.

I. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

The composition of the Council shall not exceed 18 members. The names and addresses of members who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor are:

The Council shall elect a chairman annually.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the council is to:

- a. Implement the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended, as required by S. 223 of the Act;
- b. Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control, and the Legislature regarding Montana's compliance with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Act;
- c. Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control, and the Legislature regarding other matters relating to juvenile delinquency in Montana;
- d. Ensure that juvenile justice planning and research efforts be maintained as an integral part of state government;
- e. Work with related government and private agencies to assure the coordination of activities and resources designed to improve juvenile justice in Montana.

III. DURATION


The council shall exist until December 9, 1985. This order is effective immediately.
