EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE YOUTH JUSTICE ADVISORY COUNCIL
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO IMPLEMENT THE
JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION ACT AS AMENDED

I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, hereby repeal Executive Order No. 14-83 and continue the Youth Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Justice pursuant to Section 2-15-122, MCA, and as required by Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-415), as amended.

II. PURPOSE.

The purpose of the Council is to:


- a. Supervise the preparation, complete administration and implementation of the Juvenile Justice and Prevention Act of 1974, as amended, as required by S. 223 of the Act.
- b. Approve the annual plan as required by the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended and award grants to implement that plan.
- c. Establish program policies and priorities and ensure proper program function through council staff.
- d. Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control, and the Legislature regarding Montana's compliance with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Act.
- e. Advise the Governor, the Board of Crime Control, and the Legislature regarding other matters relating to Juvenile Delinquency in Montana.
- f. Ensure that Juvenile Justice Planning and Research efforts be maintained as an integral part of state government.
- g. Work with related government and private agencies to assure the coordination of activities and resource designed to improve juvenile justice in Montana.

III. DURATION.

The Council shall exist until December 9, 198~~5~~.
