EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING CONDITIONS AS  
DEFINED BY SECTION 10-3-303, MCA,  
EXIST IN TREASURE COUNTY

---

WHEREAS, flooding has caused severe damage to roads, bridges, bridge approaches, culverts and other facilities within Treasure County; and

WHEREAS, the county has committed all available resources, taken all possible action to respond, mitigate and alleviate the situation, and local resources are not sufficient to meet the conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Treasure County Board of Commissioners has exhausted all available emergency levies by appropriating emergency funding in an amount equivalent to a two (2) mill levy on the taxable valuation of the county pursuant to Section 10-3-405, MCA and has requested that an executive order be issued declaring that conditions as defined by Section 10-3-303, MCA, exist as a result of the flooding; and


WHEREAS, Section 10-3-311(2), MCA is not applicable to Treasure County; and

WHEREAS, such an executive order authorizes the Governor under


conditions as defined by Section 10-3-303, MCA, exist in Treasure County.
