Executive Order No. 15-79

Executive Order declaring a State of Emergency and ordering sufficient personnel of the Montana National Guard into active duty as provided for in Article VI, Section 13, of the Constitution of Montana.

I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, in accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, do hereby declare that a state of emergency exists in the town of Dillon, Montana, due to a crash of an aircraft into a grain elevator causing an explosion, fire and catastrophic damage to the town, and direct the Adjutant General, Department of Military Affairs, to order to state active duty such units and personnel of the Montana National Guard as may be required to render aid and assistance to the people of Dillon, Montana, and to help in the prevention of major property damage and to provide security as needed. Pay and expenses as a result of this duty will be processed in accordance with Sections 10-1-501 and 10-1- 502, MCA.

Given under my hand and the GREAT SEAL of the State of Montana this 4th day of September, in the year of our LORD, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.
