EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAIMING A STATE OF EMERGENCY
TO EXIST AS A RESULT OF WILDLAND
FIRES AFFECTING GLACIER, TOOLE, PONDERA, TETON,
LEWIS & CLARK, CASCADE, JUDITH BASIN, MEAGHER,
BROADWATER, PARK, GALLATIN & JEFFERSON COUNTIES

WHEREAS, extremely dry conditions and high winds have combined to create hazardous fire conditions in identified areas of the state; and

WHEREAS, fires are currently burning and have created imminent threat of a disaster which timely action can avert or minimize.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor under the Constitution of the State of Montana, Title 10, Chapter 3, MCA, and under other applicable statutes, so hereby declare that a state of emergency exists in the State of Montana as defined in Sections 10-3-103 and 10-3-302, MCA.


This order is effective immediately.
