EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING
THE WOMEN IN EMPLOYMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

OF MONTANA

I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, including section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby continue the Women in Employment Advisory Council.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Council is to gather information, furnish advice and make periodic recommendations to the Governor and perform such other activities as may be necessary or assigned by the Governor of his designee to enable women to contribute to society to their fullest possible potential. The council shall:

1. evaluate the changing employment needs and problems of


women in Montana;

2. direct public attention to critical employment problems confronting women as wives, mothers, homemakers and workers;
3. evaluate ways in which to curb job discrimination and expand employment rights and opportunities available to the women of this state;
4. encourage women's organizations and other groups to institute local self-help activities designed to meet women's employment and related needs;
5. propose ways in which employment barriers faced by economically disadvantaged women may be eased; and
6. propose measures that will enable women to participate freely in the labor force and to increase their earned income.

III. DURATION

This order is effective August 9, 1991 and shall continue until August 9, 1993.
