EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE
MONTANA HISTORICAL RECORDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

12 WHEREAS, Public Law 93-536 requires the Governor of each
13 state desiring to participate in the National Historical
14 Publications Program to establish an Historical Records Advisory
15 Council; and

16 WHEREAS, the State of Montana has demonstrated an interest
17 in the care of historical records.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARC RACICOT, Governor of the State of
19 Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the
20 Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, specifically 2-
21 15-122, MCA, and Public Law 93-536, do hereby continue the
22 Montana Historical Records Advisory Council.

23 I. PURPOSE

24 Pursuant to Public Law 93-536 and the implementing
25 regulations, the Council shall serve as the central advisory
26 body in the State of Montana for the care, storage, and
27 disposition of historical records, and shall review and evaluate
28 grant proposals made to the National Historical Publications and

1 Records Commission (NHPRC), an Office of the National Archives
2 and Records Administration. The Council is authorized to
3 receive funds pursuant to Public Law 93-536.

4 II. COMPOSITION

5 The names and addresses of members who shall serve at the
6 pleasure of the Governor are submitted by separate letter to the
7 Montana Historical Society and the Secretary of State.


8 III. ADMINISTRATION

9 The Council shall be attached to the Montana Historical
10 Society for administrative purposes.


11 IV. DURATION

12 The Council shall exist for a period of two years from the
13 effective date of this Order unless extended by subsequent
14 Executive Order. This Order is effective immediately.
