EXECUTIVE ORDER CHANGING THE NAME OF
THE EARLY INTERVENTION ADVISORY COUNCIL
TO FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, in Executive Order No. 12-87, I created the Montana Interagency Coordinating Council, so named to comply with federal requirements, and, in order to distinguish it from another council of the same name, ordered that the Council also be known as the "Early Intervention Advisory Council"; and

WHEREAS, the Council has requested that the name "Early Intervention Advisory Council" be changed to "Family Support Services Advisory Council" to reflect the function of the Council, which is to assist providing support services to families rather than assist in removing children from homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TED SCHWINDEN, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, specifically section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby order that the Montana Interagency Coordinating Council shall be known as the "Family Support Services Advisory Council" rather than the "Early Intervention Advisory Council."


This Order is effective immediately.
