CONTINUATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12-87 THAT ESTABLISHES  
THE MONTANA INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCIL  
ALSO KNOWN AS THE EARLY INTERVENTION ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 12-87 expired on July 2, 1989;

WHEREAS, the Montana Interagency Coordinating Council, also known as Early Intervention Advisory Council's continued existence will serve as a public interest; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services shall review the functions and membership of the Advisory Council and provide such recommendations to the Office of the Governor on or before September 15, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, specifically Section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby extend Executive Order No. 12-87 and the membership of that Advisory council until September 30, 1989.
